#### Yardage:

# Rectangle Throw 51" x 59" approximately after borders

Light 1 2/3 yards

Scraps 1/8 yard of 40 fabrics OR

3 Charm Packs OR 1 Jelly Roll OR 1 ModaLayer Cake OR

1 Hoffman Crackers

Accent Border1/4 yardMain Border1 1/4 yardsBinding1/2 yard

Batting 2 yards if 96" or wider

With the Charm Pack you have no way to go larger, using the other 4 options, you can always increase the quilt but you need to also increase the light fabric

Clear Ruler (at least 6" x 12")

Marking Pen/Pencil (light and dark)
Scissors

Power Strip/Extension Cord

Rotary Cutter and Mat

Thread Seam Ripper

Spray Sizing

Heavy Duty/Fine Grit Sandpaper

### Each \* represents a new cutting instruction from your yardage piece

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Cutting:
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Light

\* Cut 2 3/4" x 40" strips 18 needed

*cut apart at 2 3/4" intervals (2 3/4" x 2 3/4" squares)* 240 needed

# Scraps

\* From 3 Charm Square Packs

2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares

6 needed for each of the 40 fabrics

6 needed for each of the 40 fabrics From each square, you will get 2 - 2 1/2" squares and 2 - 1 1/2" squares,

repeat this same cutting for all 3 Charm Square Packs

\* From 1/8 yard or Jelly Roll cut

2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares

6 needed for each of the 40 fabrics 6 needed for each of the 40 fabrics

\* From Layer Carke or Hoffman Crackers cut

5" squares

4 needed froom each of the 40 fabrics

from 3 of the squares for each fabric, cut

2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares 6 needed for each of the 40 fabrics 6 needed for each of the 40 fabrics

There will be one 5" square that won't be used from each of the 40 fabrics
