## Yardage:

	6 blocks	
	31 1/2" x 46 1/2" approximately before borders	
	49 1/2" x 64 1/2" approximately after borders	
Light		1 1/2 yards
Complimentary Color		2/3 yard
Scraps (10 fabrics)		fat quarter of each <b>OR</b>
		1 Charm Square Pack
1st Border (light)		5/8 yard
2nd Border (complimentary color)		1 1/8 yards
Binding		1/2 yard
Backing		3 1/8 yards

## Supplies:

Sewing Machine and Manual	Rotary Cutter and Mat
Clear Ruler	Bias Square Ruler™
Thread	Scissors
Pins	Marking Pen and Pencil
Seam Ripper	Tape Measure
Glue Stik	Post-it-Notes™
Power Strip and Extension Cord	1 yard flannel (for wall)

## Optional Supplies:

Portable design wall  
15" or larger square (for squaring blocks)  
Clamp-on light

Cutting:

Light

Cut  $8\frac{1}{4}$ " x 40" strips  
2 needed

cut apart at  $8\frac{1}{4}$ " intervals ( $8\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{4}$ " squares)  
6 needed

Cut 2" x 40" strips  
5 needed

cut apart at mid point (roughly 20")  
10 needed

remaining fabric to be cut later

Complimentary Color

Cut  $8\frac{1}{4}$ " x 40" strips  
2 needed

cut apart at  $8\frac{1}{4}$ " intervals ( $8\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{4}$ " squares)  
6 needed

from remainder .... cut the short distance into 2" strips, then subcut those  
strips into 2" squares  
7 needed

Scraps (repeat using all 10 fabrics)

Cut 2" x 20" strips  
2 needed

from one strip .... cut apart at 2" intervals (2" x 2" square)  
2 needed

OR

Scraps (Charm Squares Packs)

1 pack needed

cut each square into 4 smaller squares that are 2" x 2"  
114 needed
