

Curved Log Cabin

Yardage:

42 1/2" x 42 1/2" before borders
57" x 57" after borders

Lights	5/8 yard each of 4 fabrics
Darks	5/8 yard each of 4 fabrics
Complementary Color	1/4 yard
Border 1 (complementary color)	1/4 yard
Border 2 (one of the lights)	1/2 yard
Border 3 (one of the darks)	1 1/2 yards
Backing	3 1/2 yards
Binding	1/2 yard

Supplies:

Clear Ruler	Rotary Cutter and Mat
Thread	6" (or larger) Square Ruler
Scissors	Pins
Seam Ripper	Tape Measure
Glue Stick	6 or so baggies

When sewing, you may find you have too many or not enough strips of each fabric start with the amounts below and then wait and see it's all about the width measurement of your fabrics and how much space you leave between the strips (will wxplain in class)
